

Klaas Muller wil chair BRAFA

Belgian art dealer Klaas Muller has been elected Chairman of the Brussels Antiques & Fine Arts Fair (BRAFA). Muller succeeds fellow gallerist Harold t'Kint de Roodenbeke in the role, who has served for four consecutive terms. Joining Muller on the Board of Directors will be Christophe Boon (Boon Gallery), Didier Claes (Claes Gallery), Tobias Desmet (Gallery Desmet), Arnaud Jaspar-Costermans (Costermans & Pelgrims de Bigard), Jean Lemaire (Lemaire) and Herwig Simons (Herwig Simons Fine Arts).

Muller was born in 1975 in Lokeren. He studied art history at University Gent, and opened his eponymous gallery in Brussels in 2000. He specialises in Flemish old master paintings, especially the work, students and studio of Peter Paul Rubens, as well as 16th and 17th century drawings and sculptures. He has been a member of BRAFA since 2004, and has been on the Board of Directors since 2015, serving as Vice-Chairman (Antiques and Old Masters) since 2021.

The next edition of BRAFA will take place from 26 January to 2 February 2025.
